7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 1210.507, as last amended by Section 3,  
9 Chapter 289, O.S.L. 2006 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section  
10 1210.507), which relates to the Oklahoma School  
11 Testing Program Act; providing for testing of  
12 students enrolled in schools not operated or  
13 authorized by district of residence; and providing an  
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1210.507, as  
17 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 289, O.S.L. 2006 (70 O.S. Supp.  
18 2009, Section 1210.507), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1210.507 A. The State Board of Education shall  
20 promulgate rules necessary for the implementation and administration  
21 of the provisions of the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act.

22 B. The State Board of Education shall require school district  
23 boards of education to annually provide information to the  
24 district's students, parents of students, and the public at large  
about the proper meaning and use of tests administered pursuant to  
the provisions of the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act. The

1 Department shall develop materials and make them available to school  
2 districts regarding the Oklahoma School Testing Program. Students  
3 enrolled in any district, program or charter school that is not  
4 operated or authorized by their district of residence shall have the  
5 opportunity to be administered any test required by the Oklahoma  
6 School Testing Program Act, or any other test generally required of  
7 Oklahoma students, at a location either in their district of  
8 residence, or at a location less than one hundred (100) miles from  
9 the boundary of their district of residence.

10 C. The State Board of Education shall seek to establish and  
11 post on the Internet a sample test item bank that will be made  
12 available to teachers and will allow them to create and deliver  
13 classroom assessments throughout the school year to check for  
14 student mastery of key concepts assessed by the criterion-referenced  
15 tests administered to students pursuant to the Oklahoma School  
16 Testing Program Act. Subject to the availability of funds, the  
17 Board shall annually release end-of-instruction test items and make  
18 them available to the public.

19 D. The State Board of Education shall post on the Internet  
20 criterion-referenced sample tests for each grade level and subject  
21 matter test administered to students pursuant to the Oklahoma School  
22 Testing Program Act for the purpose of communicating expectation  
23 concerning test difficulty level and format to teacher, parents and  
24 students. The Board shall maintain the sample tests on the Internet

1 throughout the year and, as changes are made in the state academic  
2 content standards, known as the Priority Academic Student Skills  
3 Curriculum, the Board shall update the sample tests. The Board  
4 shall seek to expand the number of sample test items each year and  
5 to revise test items as needed. The sample tests shall reflect the  
6 actual test administered to students and may contain questions used  
7 on actual tests given in previous years.

8 E. The State Board of Education shall seek to implement an  
9 electronic delivery system for all tests administered pursuant to  
10 the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act that will allow students to  
11 participate in computer-based assessments in order to expedite the  
12 delivery and use of the test results.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
