7 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.  
8 2001, Section 47-103, which relates to members of the  
9 city planning commission; restricting certain persons  
from serving on certain committees or commissions;  
and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 47-103, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 47-103. The city planning commission shall consist of  
15 nine (9) members to be appointed by the mayor, if the mayor be an  
16 elective officer, otherwise by such officer as the council may  
17 designate as the appointing power in the ordinance creating the  
18 commission. In a municipality which is divided into wards or other  
19 subdivisions for the election of members of the council, one member  
20 shall be appointed to the planning commission from each of the wards  
21 or subdivisions. All members of the commission shall serve as such  
22 without compensation, and the members shall hold no other municipal  
23 office, except that one member may be a member of the zoning board  
24 of adjustment or appeals and no more than four members may serve on

1 design committees or commissions. The term of each member shall be  
2 six (6) years or until his or her successor is appointed and  
3 qualified; except that when the commission is first appointed, the  
4 respective terms of three of the members shall be three (3), four  
5 (4) and five (5) years. Members may be removed by the mayor, after  
6 a public hearing, for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance  
7 in office. The mayor shall file a written statement of reasons for  
8 the removal. Vacancies occurring otherwise than through the  
9 expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term by the  
10 mayor or by the appointing power designated by the council in  
11 municipalities in which the mayor is not an elective officer.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
