11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 160.3 of Title 62, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
16 for the Office of the State Treasurer to be designated the "Oklahoma  
17 Centennial Botanical Garden Authority Revolving Fund". The fund  
18 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,  
19 and shall consist of all monies accruing to the Authority by  
20 appropriation and Oklahoma Centennial Botanical Garden operations.  
21 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
22 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of the  
23 State Treasurer for the purpose of further development and operation  
24 of the Oklahoma Centennial Botanical Garden. Expenditures from the

1 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
2 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State  
3 Finance for approval and payment.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
