7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Highway Remediation
8 and Cleanup Services Act; stating exceptions for
9 certain railroads and electric utilities; providing
10 for codification; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-406 of Title 27A, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and
16 Cleanup Services Act shall not apply to discharges or spills from
17 rail transportation, vehicles or cargo at locations including, but
18 not limited to, highway, street or road intersections or other
19 locations involving railroad tracks.

20 B. The provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and
21 Cleanup Services Act shall not apply to discharges or spills from
22 vehicles, cargo or electrical equipment under the control of an
23 electric utility.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
