12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.20 of Title 59, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Online  
17 Construction Registry Act".

18 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.21 of Title 59, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The purpose of this act is to create and maintain an online  
22 registry for full disclosure to property owners, contractors and  
23 other interested parties, of people providing goods and services to  
24 a construction project. The Legislature finds that by providing a

1 centralized resource for project participant information, the Online  
2 Construction Registry Act will help property owners minimize unknown  
3 project liability and risk. The Legislature further finds that the  
4 Online Construction Registry Act also will implement an efficient  
5 and standardized system for protecting lien rights associated with  
6 all types of construction projects - residential, public and  
7 commercial.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
