relates to recreating certain entities; and modifying

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3904, as
13 amended by Section 1, Chapter 26, O.S.L. 2003 (74 O.S. Supp. 2008,
14 Section 3904), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 3904. The following statutory entities and their
16 successors shall be terminated on July 1, ~~2009~~ 2015, and all powers,
17 duties and functions shall be abolished one (1) year thereafter:

18 1. State Board of Cosmetology as created by Section 199.2 of
19 Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

20 2. State Barber Advisory Board as created by Section 61.4 of
21 Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 3. Oklahoma Real Estate Commission as created by Section 858-
23 201 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 4. State Board of Examiners of Psychologists as created by
2 Section 1354 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 5. Scenic River Commission as created by Section 1461 of Title
4 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 6. Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Advisory Committee as
6 created by Section 3-312 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 7. State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as created
8 by Section 481 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

9 8. Group Homes for Persons with Developmental or Physical
10 Disabilities Advisory Board as created by Section 1430.4 of Title 10
11 of the Oklahoma Statutes, ~~and~~

12 ~~9. Ottawa Reclamation Authority as created by Section 801 of~~
13 ~~Title 45 of the Oklahoma Statutes.~~
