12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-722.1 of Title 63, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The Oklahoma Health Information Security and Privacy  
17 Collaboration (OKHISPC) shall evaluate potential barriers to the  
18 broad adoption of standards-based electronic health information  
19 systems, including electronic health records and statewide health  
20 information exchange. These barriers may include, but are not  
21 limited to:

- 22 1. Broadband access;  
23 2. Penetration;  
24 3. Capacity;

1 4. Application program interface availability and development;  
2 and

3 5. Health information technology (HIT) systems acquisition and  
4 ongoing operational costs, including hardware, software, licensing,  
5 support staff, and training expenses.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
