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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-4-106 of Title 27A, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. State agencies shall develop an energy efficiency and  
16 conservation plan. State agencies shall designate a person to  
17 develop and implement this energy efficiency and conservation plan.  
18 Agencies shall make every effort to include in the plans strategies  
19 that:

20 1. Reduce energy consumption, including both electrical and  
21 fuel consumption, by:

22 a. ten percent (10%) within the first five (5) years of  
23 implementation,

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- 1           b.    twenty percent (20%) within the first ten (10) years  
2                   of implementation, and  
3           c.    thirty percent (30%) within the first fifteen (15)  
4                   years of implementation.

5           2.    Provide for purchasing preferences for the acquisition of  
6 energy-efficient products including, but not limited to, Energy Star  
7 compliant appliances;

8           3.    Evaluate and, where appropriate, utilize on-site renewable  
9 energy for space conditioning and water heating, including, but not  
10 limited to, solar water heating and geothermal heat pumps in all new  
11 and replacement buildings and major renovations of buildings;

12           4.    Provide for purchasing preferences for the acquisition of  
13 vehicles that utilize alternative fuel sources including, but not  
14 limited to, compressed natural gas, hybrid power or biofuels; and

15           5.    Provide a preference for the utilization of alternative  
16 energy sources including, but not limited to, biofuels, solar,  
17 geothermal, hydrogen, and wind.

18           B.    The Director of the Department of Central Services shall  
19 appoint an ombudsman to serve as a repository for the energy  
20 efficiency and conservation plans of each agency. The ombudsman  
21 shall research and use best available methods to measure energy  
22 consumption, and aid agencies in implementing and monitoring the  
23 implementation of the plans.

1 C. Any reduced expenditures of appropriated dollars resulting  
2 from the energy savings achieved by any agency through the  
3 implementation of the plan shall be disbursed as follows:

4 1. Three-fourths (3/4) of the savings shall be kept by the  
5 agency; and

6 2. One-fourth (1/4) of the savings shall be deposited in the  
7 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
