12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office
14 of the State Bond Advisor shall budget all funds in the following
15 categories and amounts:

20 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for

22 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
23 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Office of the State Bond Advisor by law shall be set by the

1 State Bond Advisor. The Office of the State Bond Advisor for the
2 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
3 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
4 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
5 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
6 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
