7 A Concurrent Resolution relating to adjournment of  
the legislative session; modifying date on which the  
8 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature will  
adjourn sine die; prohibiting consideration of  
9 certain conference committee reports; and requiring  
revision of legislative calendar.

12 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Constitution establishes the first Monday  
13 in February as the day on which the regular legislative session  
14 commences; and

15 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Constitution also requires that the  
16 regular session be finally adjourned sine die not later than the  
17 last Friday in May; and

18 WHEREAS, based on these parameters, the legislative calendar for  
19 the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature began on February  
20 2, 2009, and will end on May 29, 2009, and will extend beyond  
21 Memorial Day; and

22 WHEREAS, the Legislature has customarily completed its work in  
23 a timely manner prior to Memorial Day.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
2 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
3 CONCURRING THEREIN:

4 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature will adjourn sine die not later  
5 than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 22, 2009.

6 THAT no conference committee report shall be considered by  
7 either the Senate or the House of Representatives unless the report  
8 has been properly filed in the house of origin not later than May  
9 11, 2009. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker  
10 of the House of Representatives may jointly waive this provision or  
11 permit consideration of a conference committee report on a measure  
12 which has been returned to a conference committee for further  
13 consideration. This provision shall not apply to:

14 1. A report on a measure which either the Senate or the House  
15 of Representatives, or both, have assigned to the General Conference  
16 Committee on Appropriations; or

17 2. A conference committee report that states that the conferees  
18 are unable to agree.

19 THAT the legislative calendar for the 1st Session of the 52nd  
20 Oklahoma Legislature be revised to reflect these changes.
