17 Broxton Lady Mustangs for winning the 2009 Class A  
18 fast-pitch softball state championship; and directing  
19 distribution.

20 WHEREAS, the Fort Cobb-Broxton Lady Mustangs have always been  
21 competitive, whether in slow-pitch or fast-pitch softball. The Lady  
22 Mustangs were runners-up in the fast-pitch finals in 2007; and

23 WHEREAS, Lady Mustangs Coach Kelly Pierce decided to change his  
24 line-up during the 2009 fast-pitch softball championship game

1 against the top-ranked Fletcher Lady Wildcats by sending in Freshman  
2 Ashton Lierle to pitch and assigning senior pitcher Adalynn Klugh to  
3 the shortstop position; and

4 WHEREAS, the new line-up worked as the Fletcher team, which had  
5 faced Adalynn Klugh before, was unfamiliar with Ashton Lierle; and  
6 Adalynn's defensive play and at-bat prowess proved decisive.

7 Adalynn Klugh hit the game-winning run batted in (RBI) in her last  
8 two championship games, and Coach Pierce's team won its first fast-  
9 pitch softball state championship on the same ASA field where his  
10 team prevailed in its slow-pitch softball state championship game.
