21 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Junior Miss Scholarship Program is held  
22 annually to honor the best and brightest high school senior girls in  
23 Oklahoma. This statewide scholarship and honors program recognizes,  
24 rewards, and encourages excellence while promoting self-esteem among

1 these young women. The 2010 Oklahoma Junior Miss Scholarship  
2 Program occurred on Saturday, March 20, 2010, at the Bartlesville  
3 Community Center, with five high school senior young women competing  
4 from local and at-large programs from across Oklahoma; and

5 WHEREAS, Miss Ali Aufleger, daughter of Howard and Melinda of  
6 Stillwater, was selected as 2010 Oklahoma Junior Miss, winning the  
7 Spirit, Interview, Talent, and Self-Expression awards, and a total  
8 of \$2,200 in cash college scholarships; and

9 WHEREAS, by being selected the 2010 Oklahoma Junior Miss, Miss  
10 Aufleger will be involved in community service, speaking and  
11 performing engagements around the State of Oklahoma, and presenting  
12 the "Be Your Best Self" message of Self-Confidence and Commitment to  
13 Oklahoma's school children; and

14 WHEREAS, by being selected the 2010 Oklahoma Junior Miss, Miss  
15 Aufleger is automatically entered in the America's Junior Miss  
16 Scholarship Program to be held June 13-26, 2010, in Mobile, Alabama.  
17 Miss Aufleger will compete for the national title with 49 other high  
18 school senior young women, one from each state, in the categories of  
19 Fitness, Interview, Self-Expression, Talent, and Scholastics for a  
20 Share of \$75,000 in college scholarships.
