An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; making a transfer between funds in the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; stating purpose; exempting certain funds from fiscal year limitations; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is hereby authorized to transfer from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Fund ("490 Fund") to the CMIA Programs Disbursing Fund ("340 Fund") of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, the sum of Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by law.

SECTION 2. The transfer authorized by Section 1 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the effective date of this act.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
