An Act relating to appropriations; making an appropriation; stating purpose; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of Fourteen Million Four Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,415,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the provisions of Sections 2006 through 2013 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
