An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
designating the CWO2 Steven Shephard Memorial
Highway; providing for permanent markers; providing
for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.44 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A portion of Interstate 35, beginning at mile marker 100
extending south to Purcell, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
"CWO2 Steven Shephard Memorial Highway". The Department of
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
on the highway bearing that name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
