An Act relating to state government; providing for the Oklahoma Statutes 2011 and annual cumulative supplements; providing for selection of a publisher; providing for procedure for publication; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 191 of Title 75, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The "Oklahoma Statutes 2011" and annual cumulative supplements thereto shall be compiled, codified, annotated, printed and published by a publisher selected by the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, from bids submitted for that purpose. Publication shall be in accordance with the terms, specifications and conditions directed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
