An Act relating to the State Board of Education;  
amending Section 139 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1561  
of the 2nd Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature,  
which relates to appropriations to the State Board of  
Education; modifying appropriation amount; making  
appropriations; stating purposes; providing an  
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 139 of Enrolled Senate  
Bill No. 1561 of the 2nd Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature,  
is amended to read as follows:

Section 139. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of  
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 2011, the sum of ~~One Billion Seventy four Million  
Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Four Hundred Ninety five Dollars  
(\$1,074,330,495.00)~~ One Billion Sixty-five Million Eight Hundred  
Thirty Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-five Dollars (\$1,065,830,495.00)  
or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of  
public schools.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of  
Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 2011, the sum of Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand

Dollars (\$8,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be transferred to the Oklahoma Tax Commission and which shall be deposited in the Ad Valorem Reimbursement Fund created pursuant to Section 193 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the purpose of reimbursing counties for school districts that claim a loss of revenue due to a tax exemption granted for a new or expanded manufacturing or research and development facility pursuant to the provisions of Section 6B of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
