An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Sections 320 and 324.20b, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 269, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 324.20b), which relate to the State Fire Marshal; prohibiting engaging in business that is a conflict of interest; removing monetary limit on the State Fire Marshal Revolving Fund; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 320, is amended to read as follows:

Section 320. The State Fire Marshal shall not engage in any other business that may be a conflict of interest with agency business, and he the State Fire Marshal and his assistant shall at all times be ready for such duties as are required by this act Sections 314 through 324.21 of this title.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 324.20b, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 269, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 324.20b), is amended to read as follows:

Section 324.20b There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Fire Marshal to be designated the "State Fire Marshal Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of monies received from the sale of surplus property, fees and receipts

collected pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act, fines, forfeitures, fees, charges, receipts, donations, gifts, bequests, contributions, devises, interagency reimbursements, federal funds unless otherwise provided by federal law or regulation, or any other source. ~~The fund shall consist of no more than Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000.00).~~ All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State Fire Marshal for authorized purposes. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
