A Joint Resolution disapproving permanent rules of the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserved the right to designate the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent and disapprove any rule or portion thereof at any time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 230.4 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety shall be responsible for adopting and promulgating rules and regulations in order to carry out the provisions of the Oklahoma Motor Carrier Safety and Hazardous Materials Transportation Act relating to motor carrier safety in the transportation of property and hazardous materials in intrastate and interstate commerce, and for adopting by reference and enforcing all or any portion of the federal motor carrier safety regulations and the hazardous materials regulations of the United States Department of Transportation, as now or hereafter amended; and

WHEREAS, the promulgation of permanent rules OAC 595:35-1-4 and OAC 595:35-1-6, which were finally adopted by the Commissioner on March 31, 2010, do not reflect the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby disapproves permanent rules
OAC 595:35-1-4 and OAC 595:35-1-6.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is directed to distribute
copies of this resolution to the Governor, the Commissioner of the
Department of Public Safety, and the editor of "The Oklahoma
Register".
