An Act relating to the Office of State Finance;  
making an appropriation; stating purpose; making  
appropriation nonfiscal; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of State Finance from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Twenty Two Million Dollars (\$22,000,000.00) for transfer to the Voluntary Buy-Out Agency Reimbursement Revolving Fund created pursuant to Enrolled House Bill 2363 of the Second Session of the 52nd Legislature for the purpose of making qualified payments related to the voluntary buyout program expenditures to achieve payroll and operational savings in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
