An Act relating to the district courts; amending Section 132 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1561 of the 2nd Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to certain authorization; changing certain amount; amending Section 133 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1561 of the 2nd Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to certain appropriations; changing certain amount; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 132 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1561 of the 2nd Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 132. The Supreme Court is hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, from the State Judicial Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of ~~Forty Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$40,800,000.00)~~ Fifty-one Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$51,600,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of the District Courts.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 133 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1561 of the 2nd Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 133. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of ~~Six Million Eight Hundred Forty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$6,841,865.00)~~ Six Million Forty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$6,041,865.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the District Courts by law.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
