An Act relating to counties and county officers;
authorizing circuit engineering districts to
establish County Energy District Authorities; stating
procedures; providing for appointment of trustees and
officers; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 460.2a of Title 19, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The board of directors of a circuit engineering district,
established pursuant to Section 687.1 et seq. of Title 69 of the
Oklahoma Statutes, may by resolution, establish a County Energy
District Authority pursuant to the provisions of this act, for the
district. The authority shall be a public trust as provided for in
Sections 176 through 180.3 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. The authority shall consist of five (5) trustees as follows:

1. Three members of the board of directors of the circuit
engineering district; and

2. Two persons appointed by the board of directors of the circuit engineering district. The appointed members shall be residents of the district and shall not be elected officials.

C. The chair of the board of directors of the circuit engineering district shall serve as chair of the authority.
