An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 2152, which relates to the donation of blood; permitting a person sixteen years of age to donate blood under certain circumstance; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 2152, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2152. Any person sixteen (16) years of age with parental permission or authorization, or seventeen (17) years of age or older without parental permission or authorization shall be eligible to donate blood voluntarily ~~without the necessity of obtaining parental permission or authorization~~; provided that only persons eighteen (18) years of age or older may receive compensation for blood so donated.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
