An Act relating to state government; exempting certain contractual agreements entered into by the Native American Cultural and Educational Authority from certain approvals and requirements; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1226.4A of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

With respect to approval of agreements for the planning, construction, development, operation, maintenance, and administration of commercial facilities which support, enhance, or contribute to the American Indian Cultural Center, the Native American Cultural and Educational Authority, notwithstanding any other provision of law, may enter into contractual agreements without approval from the Oklahoma Department of Central Services, and the provisions of the Public Building Construction and Planning

Act, Section 202 et seq. of Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes and Sections 60 through 65 of Title 61 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall not apply. With the exception of the development of the commercial facilities described in this section, this section shall not be construed to enlarge the powers of the Native American Cultural and Educational Authority.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
