An Act relating to counties and county officers;
creating the Marvin Williams and Robbie Chase
Whitebird County Sheriff Assistance Act; providing
short title; authorizing certain nonprofit
corporations to offer certain services under certain
circumstances; providing for noncodification;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Marvin Williams
and Robbie Chase Whitebird County Sheriff Assistance Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 556 of Title 19, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A corporation organized not-for-profit pursuant to the
provisions of the Oklahoma General Corporation Act and that holds a
valid exemption from federal income taxation issued pursuant to
Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. Section
501(a)) and is listed as an exempt organization in Section 501(c) of
the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. Section 501(c)) and is a
statewide association of county sheriffs that represents the largest
association of elected sheriffs of this state is hereby authorized

to provide any available support services and/or assist in coordinating county law enforcement resources when any sheriff of this state requests such assistance.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
