An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tax Commission;
making an appropriation; stating purpose; making
appropriation nonfiscal; making appropriation exempt
from certain agency category and budget limits;
making appropriation nonfiscal; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tax Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of funding the Oklahoma State University Center for Local Government Technology for the performance of its duties as required by statute.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal years 2009 and 2010 agency category and budget limits.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
