An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 590, which relates to prohibition of employment of a state officer; providing for penalty; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 590, is amended to read as follows:

Section 590. A. Any state officer or employee who exercises discretionary or decision-making authority in awarding a privatization contract shall be prohibited for a period of one (1) year from the date that the privatization contract is awarded from becoming an officer or employee of a business organization which is a party to any privatization contract with the state agency in which the state officer or employee exercised such discretionary or decision-making authority.

B. In the event of a violation of the provisions of subsection A of this section, the business organization shall be prohibited, for a period of one (1) year from the date of the violation, from contracting with the state agency in which the state officer or state employee exercised discretionary or decision-making authority.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
