A Concurrent Resolution relating to the sine die adjournment of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature; providing for extension of sine die adjournment.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives have adopted Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 12 fixing the date and time of sine die adjournment of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature as May 22, 2009, at 5 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature may require additional time authorized pursuant to Section 26 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution in order to consider and pass measures that are of importance that would otherwise remain on the respective calendars of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate if the prescribed sine die adjournment date of May 22 occurred; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives mutually agree to extend the date and time for the sine die adjournment of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1st SESSION OF THE 52nd OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives rescind the proposed sine die adjournment date of May 22, 2009, at 5 p.m. as contained in Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 12 of the 1st Session of the 52nd Legislature.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of Representatives will adjourn sine die at such time as may be declared by the Presiding Officer of the respective chambers but in no case later than Wednesday, May 27, 2009, at 11:59 p.m.
