WHEREAS, "We the People: The Citizen and the Constitution" is a  
project of the Center for Civic Education. Their goal is to promote  
civic competence and responsibility among the nation's elementary  
and secondary students. The instructional program enhances  
students' understanding of the institutions of American  
constitutional democracy; and

WHEREAS, the culminating activity is a simulated congressional  
hearing in which students "testify" before a panel of judges.  
Students demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of  
constitutional principles and have opportunities to evaluate, take,

and defend positions on relevant historical and contemporary issues. Since the inception of the We the People program in 1987, more than 28 million students and 90,000 educators have participated in this innovative course of study; and

WHEREAS, Enid High School began competition in the late 1980s as the program was inaugurated. Since then they have won the state competition 16 times, and four out of the last five years; and

WHEREAS, this year fourteen senior Enid High School students won at the congressional district level and then advanced and won at the state level. They will represent Oklahoma in national competition in Washington, D.C., this April.
