A Resolution congratulating the Boynton-Moton High School Lady Cardinals girls basketball team for winning the 2010 Class B State Championship; commending them for winning the first girls basketball state championship in the school's history; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Boynton, Oklahoma, home of Boynton-Moton High School, is a small town of approximately 300 residents located in Muskogee County. The high school is the core of the community's existence; and

WHEREAS, Shartese McHenry is in her second year as head coach at Boynton-Moton. In her first year she coached the Lady Cardinals to a 21-8 record and the area tournament. Hers is a basketball family and one centered in Boynton, Oklahoma. She is also the founder and director of a non-profit organization that encourages students to become involved in community projects. Under her coaching leadership the Lady Cardinals finished the 2009-2010 season with a 30-4 record and the sought-after gold ball indicating a state championship; and

WHEREAS, spectators from Boynton, Moton, Taft, and surrounding areas attended the 2010 state tournament at the state fair arena in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to support their Lady Cardinals. This was the team's first trip to the state tournament since 1975. The fifth-ranked Cardinals won five consecutive games including a defeat of first ranked Cyril 54-48 in the championship game. By doing so they won the first girls state basketball championship in the high school's history.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Boynton-Moton High School Lady Cardinals girls basketball team for winning the girls basketball 2010 Class B State Championship.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the Boynton-Moton High School Lady Cardinals girls basketball team for winning their first state championship in the school's history and compiling a 30-4 season record.
