WHEREAS, on March 23, 2010, Oklahoma Baptist University (OBU),
located in Shawnee, Oklahoma, won the National Association of
Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) Men's Division I Basketball
Championship in Kansas City; and

WHEREAS, the OBU Bison came from behind to win their last four
games in the 2010 tournament by deficits of 15 points against Texas
Wesleyan, 16 against Biola; 13 against Robert Morris, and eight
against Azusa Pacific; and

WHEREAS, the Bison completed the 2009-2010 season with a 33-3 record and, with their wins in the national tournament, became the all-time leader in victories in the history of the NAIA national tournament; and

WHEREAS, OBU Head Basketball Coach Doug Tolin was named NAIA Coach of the Year. OBU forward Nate Brumfield was named NAIA Player of the Year, NAIA Tournament Most Valuable Player, and Sooner Athletic Conference (SAC) Player of the Year. Nate Brumfield, Kevin Swinton, and A. J. Hawkins were all named to the All-NAIA Tournament Team. Hawkins was also awarded the SAC Newcomer of the Year. OBU guard Garrett Steinmetz was named NAIA All-American Scholar Athlete. Tyler Parker was named Team NAIA Champion of Character.
