WHEREAS, Reverend Hassan Mansaray, the President of 4HIM Sierra Leone, has spent his life serving the needs of widows and orphaned children in the formerly war-torn country of Sierra Leone, West Africa; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Hassan Mansaray has been the overseer of emergency relief to thousands of his countrymen that has included food for the hungry, shelter for the homeless, and medical care for the war wounded, amputees, polio victims, and the sick; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Hassan Mansaray has not just provided shelter, but has been a father to more than 94 children for more than a decade, providing them with love, encouragement, and the hope of Christ; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Hassan Mansaray, since the conflict ended in Sierra Leone, has overseen the building of an orphanage, more than 23 churches, 19 schools, and a trade school for women who are victims of human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Hassan Mansaray is continuing in his work today to develop his country, enlisting the generosity of Oklahomans and the agricultural expertise of Oklahoma State University to develop the needed educational opportunities to gain the knowledge of how to grow an adequate food supply for the nation of Sierra Leone.
