A Resolution congratulating the Elk City High School boys golf team for winning the State Class 4A championship; saluting team players; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, not even a tornado or the graduation of their top golfer could prevent the Elk City High School Elks from winning the school's sixth team state championship; and

WHEREAS, the boy's golf team, led by three freshmen who scored in the 150s, won the state class 4A championship despite the 2009 graduation of Senior Tyler Russell, last year's state medal winner; and

WHEREAS, the state championship, played at Lake Hefner Golf Club, Hefner North Course, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on May 10,

2010, was temporarily shut down thanks to tornado sirens and winds in excess of 40 miles per hour. The tournament officials shortened the event from 54 to 36 holes; and

WHEREAS, despite the weather, the boy Elks, with a team score of 617, managed to overtake Guymon thanks to the trio of freshmen, two of whom are too young to legally drive a motor vehicle but not to drive a golf ball on the green.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Elk City High School boys golf team for winning the State Class 4A championship, the sixth in school history.
