1 "SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.15, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1290.15

4 PERSONS EXEMPT FROM TRAINING COURSE

5 A. The following individuals may be exempt from all or part of
6 the required training and qualification course established pursuant
7 to the provisions of Section 1290.14 of this title:

8 1. A firearms instructor registered with the Oklahoma State
9 Bureau of Investigation for purposes of the Oklahoma Self-Defense
10 Act;

11 2. An active duty law enforcement officer of this state or any
12 of its political subdivisions or of the federal government;

13 3. A retired law enforcement officer authorized by this state
14 pursuant to Section 1289.8 of this title to carry a firearm;

15 4. A CLEET-certified armed security officer, armed guard,
16 correctional officer, or any other person having a CLEET
17 certification to carry a firearm in the course of their employment;

18 5. A person on active military duty, National Guard duty or
19 regular military reserve duty who is a legal resident of this state
20 and who is trained and qualified in the use of handguns;

21 6. A person honorably discharged from active military duty,
22 National Guard duty or military reserves ~~within twenty (20) years~~
23 ~~preceding the date of the application for a concealed handgun~~
24 ~~license pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self Defense Act,~~

1 | who is a legal resident of this state, and who has been trained and
2 | qualified in the use of handguns;

3 | 7. A person retired as a peace officer in good standing from a
4 | law enforcement agency located in another state, who is a legal
5 | resident of this state, and who has received training equivalent to
6 | the training required for CLEET certification in this state; and

7 | 8. Any person who is otherwise deemed qualified for a training
8 | exemption by CLEET.

9 | Provided, however, persons applying for an exemption pursuant to
10 | paragraph 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7 of this subsection may be required to
11 | successfully complete the classroom portion of the training course.
12 | The classroom portion of the training course shall not exceed a fee
13 | of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00).

14 | B. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
15 | (CLEET) shall establish criteria for providing proof of an
16 | exemption. Before any person shall be considered exempt from all or
17 | part of the required training and qualification pursuant to the
18 | provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, Section 1290.1 et seq.
19 | of this title, the person shall present the required proof of
20 | exemption to a registered firearms instructor. Each person
21 | determined to be exempt from training or qualification as provided
22 | in this subsection shall receive an exemption certificate from the
23 | registered firearms instructor. The rules promulgated by CLEET to
24 | implement the provisions of this section and Section 1290.14 of this

1 title may require that a fee not to exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00) be
2 charged for processing an exemption certificate. The original
3 exemption certificate must be submitted with an application for a
4 handgun license as provided in paragraph 2 of Section 1290.12 of
5 this title. No person who is determined to be exempt from training
6 or qualification may carry a concealed firearm pursuant to the
7 authority of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act until issued a valid
8 handgun license.

9 C. Nothing contained in any provision of the Oklahoma Self-
10 Defense Act shall be construed to alter, amend, or modify the
11 authority of any active duty law enforcement officer, or any person
12 certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
13 to carry a pistol during the course of their employment, from
14 carrying any pistol in any manner authorized by law or authorized by
15 the employing agency."
