1 "SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290, as
2 last amended by Section 16, Chapter 3, O.S.L. 2008 (21 O.S. Supp.
3 2008, Section 1290.5), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1290.5

5 TERM OF LICENSE AND RENEWAL

6 A. A concealed handgun license when issued shall authorize the
7 person to whom the license is issued to carry a loaded or unloaded
8 concealed handgun as authorized by the provisions of the Oklahoma
9 Self-Defense Act, and any future modifications thereto. The license
10 shall be valid in this state for a period of five (5) years, unless
11 subsequently surrendered, suspended or revoked as provided by law.
12 The person shall have no authority to continue to carry a concealed
13 handgun in this state pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act when
14 a license is expired or when a license has been voluntarily
15 surrendered or suspended or revoked for any reason.

16 B. A license may be renewed any time within ninety (90) days
17 prior to the expiration date as provided in this subsection. The
18 Bureau shall send a renewal application to each eligible licensee
19 with a return address requested. There shall be a thirty-day grace
20 period on license renewals beginning on the date of expiration,
21 thereafter the license is considered expired. However, any
22 applicant shall have three (3) years from the expiration of the
23 license to comply with the renewal requirements of this section.

1 1. To renew a handgun license, the licensee must first obtain a
2 renewal form from the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

3 2. The applicant must complete the renewal form, attach two
4 current passport size photographs of the applicant, and submit a
5 renewal fee in the amount of Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00) to the
6 Bureau. The renewal fee may be paid with a nationally recognized
7 credit card as provided in subparagraph b of paragraph 4 of
8 subsection A of Section 1290.12 of this title, or by a cashier's
9 check or money order made payable to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
10 Investigation.

11 3. Upon receipt of the renewal application, photographs and
12 fee, the Bureau will conduct a criminal history records name search,
13 an investigation of medical records or other records or information
14 deemed by the Bureau to be relevant to the renewal application. If
15 the applicant appears not to have any prohibition to renewing the
16 handgun license, the Bureau shall issue the renewed license for a
17 period of five (5) years.

18 C. Upon the effective date of this act, any person making
19 application for a concealed handgun license or any licensee seeking
20 to renew a concealed handgun license shall have the option to
21 request that said license be valid for a period of ten (10) years.
22 The fee for any concealed handgun license issued for a period of ten
23 (10) years shall be double the amount of the fee provided for in
24 paragraph 4 of subsection A of Section 1290.12 of this title. The

1 renewal fee for a concealed handgun license issued for a period of
2 ten (10) years shall be double the amount of the fee provided for in
3 paragraph 2 of subsection B of this section.

4 D. Beginning November 1, 2009, any person who is honorably
5 discharged from active military duty, National Guard duty or
6 military reserves and who makes application for a concealed handgun
7 license or seeks to renew a concealed handgun license shall have the
8 option to request that said license be valid for the life of the
9 person receiving the license. The fee for the concealed handgun
10 license issued pursuant to this subsection shall be One Hundred
11 Dollars (\$100.00)."
