1 "SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.5, as  
2 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 225, O.S.L. 2009 (21 O.S. Supp.  
3 2009, Section 1290.5), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1290.5.

5 TERM OF LICENSE AND RENEWAL

6 A. A concealed handgun license when issued shall authorize the  
7 person to whom the license is issued to carry a loaded or unloaded  
8 concealed handgun as authorized by the provisions of the Oklahoma  
9 Self-Defense Act, and any future modifications thereto. The Except  
10 as provided in subsection D of this section, the license shall be  
11 valid in this state for a period of five (5) or ten (10) years,  
12 unless subsequently surrendered, suspended or revoked as provided by  
13 law. The person shall have no authority to continue to carry a  
14 concealed handgun in this state pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-  
15 Defense Act when a license is expired or when a license has been  
16 voluntarily surrendered or suspended or revoked for any reason.

17 B. A license may be renewed any time within ninety (90) days  
18 prior to the expiration date as provided in this subsection. The  
19 Bureau shall send a renewal application to each eligible licensee  
20 with a return address requested. There shall be a thirty-day grace  
21 period on license renewals beginning on the date of expiration,  
22 thereafter the license is considered expired. However, any  
23 applicant shall have three (3) years from the expiration of the  
24 license to comply with the renewal requirements of this section.

1 1. To renew a handgun license, the licensee must first obtain a  
2 renewal form from the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

3 2. The applicant must complete the renewal form, attach two  
4 current passport size photographs of the applicant, and submit a  
5 renewal fee in the amount of Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00) to the  
6 Bureau. The renewal fee may be paid with a nationally recognized  
7 credit card as provided in subparagraph b of paragraph 4 of  
8 subsection A of Section 1290.12 of this title, or by a cashier's  
9 check or money order made payable to the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
10 Investigation.

11 3. Upon receipt of the renewal application, photographs and  
12 fee, the Bureau will conduct a criminal history records name search,  
13 an investigation of medical records or other records or information  
14 deemed by the Bureau to be relevant to the renewal application. If  
15 the applicant appears not to have any prohibition to renewing the  
16 handgun license, the Bureau shall issue the renewed license for a  
17 period of five (5) or ten (10) years or for a period of ninety-nine  
18 (99) years for military veterans, as provided for in subsection D of  
19 this section.

20 C. Beginning November 1, 2007, any person making application  
21 for a concealed handgun license or any licensee seeking to renew a  
22 concealed handgun license shall have the option to request that said  
23 license be valid for a period of ten (10) years. The fee for any  
24 concealed handgun license issued for a period of ten (10) years

1 shall be double the amount of the fee provided for in paragraph 4 of  
2 subsection A of Section 1290.12 of this title. The renewal fee for  
3 a concealed handgun license issued for a period of ten (10) years  
4 shall be double the amount of the fee provided for in paragraph 2 of  
5 subsection B of this section.

6 D. Any military veteran making application for a concealed  
7 handgun license shall have the option to request that said license  
8 be valid for a period of ninety-nine (99) years. The fee for a  
9 concealed handgun license issued for a period of ninety-nine (99)  
10 years shall be Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00). Any military  
11 veteran with a concealed handgun license issued prior to the  
12 effective date of this act, shall automatically have the license  
13 renewed for a period of ninety-nine (99) years. As used in this  
14 subsection, "military veteran" shall mean any person who has been  
15 honorably discharged from active military duty, National Guard duty  
16 or the military reserves."
