11 An Act relating to insurance; requiring the release
12 of certain information if certain authorization is
13 obtained; requiring the Insurance Commissioner to
14 prescribe certain form; providing exception; amending
15 36 O.S. 2001, Section 6060, as last amended by
16 Section 23, Chapter 184, O.S.L. 2008 (36 O.S. Supp.
17 2009, Section 6060), which relates to insurance
18 coverage of mammography screening; prohibiting
19 insurers from modifying benefits without legislative
20 approval; expanding coverage of mammography for
21 certain persons; providing for codification; and
22 providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1435.41 of Title 36, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. An insurer shall provide to any insurance producer
authorized to sell life insurance products, whose appointment has

1 | been terminated for any reason other than the reasons set forth in
2 | Section 1435.13 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes and is still
3 | the agent of record or servicing agent and has not been replaced by
4 | another servicing agent upon termination, information relating to
5 | the policy of the person who purchased a product from such producer
6 | if the insured has signed a form authorizing the release of the
7 | information.

8 | B. The Insurance Commissioner shall prescribe the form required
9 | by subsection A of this section. The form shall be in compliance
10 | with federal and state laws and regulations relating to privacy.

11 | C. This section shall not apply to any policy sold or serviced
12 | by the insurance producer while associated with the insurer's
13 | captive distribution system.

14 | SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2001, Section 6060, as
15 | last amended by Section 23, Chapter 184, O.S.L. 2008 (36 O.S. Supp.
16 | 2009, Section 6060), is amended to read as follows:

17 | Section 6060. A. All individual and group health insurance
18 | policies providing coverage on an expense incurred basis, and all
19 | individual and group service or indemnity type contracts issued by a
20 | nonprofit corporation, including the Oklahoma State and Education
21 | Employees Group Insurance Board, which provide coverage for a female
22 | thirty-five (35) years old or older in this state, except for
23 | policies that provide coverage for specified disease or other
24 | limited benefit coverage, shall include the coverage specified by

1 this section for a mammography screening in a reimbursement amount
2 not to exceed One Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$115.00) for the presence
3 of occult breast cancer. Such coverage shall not:

4 1. Be subject to modification by insurers based upon studies or
5 recommendations of medical research entities without specific
6 approval of the Legislature;

7 2. Be subject to the policy deductible, copayments and
8 coinsurance limits of the plan; or

9 ~~2.~~ 3. Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at
10 a specified time as a condition of payment.

11 B. 1. Any female thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39)
12 years of age shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this
13 section to coverage for a mammography screening once every five (5)
14 years.

15 2. Any female forty (40) years of age or older shall be
16 entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for
17 an annual mammography screening.

18 3. Any female under thirty-five (35) years of age shall be
19 entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for
20 mammography screening, provided the treating physician prescribes
21 the screening based upon physical findings or a genetic
22 predisposition to breast cancer.

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1 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
