House Bill No. 1080

HOUSE BILL NO. 1080 - By: GLENN of the House and WYRICK of the Senate.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the TSGT Jason Norton Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 1698.43 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in  
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge that crosses the Neosho River on State Highway 125 at Riverview Park  
5 in Miami, Oklahoma, shall be designated the "TSGT Jason Norton Memorial Bridge".  
6 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
7 on the highway bearing that name.

8 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof  
10 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
