House Bill No. 1084

HOUSE BILL NO. 1084 - By: THOMSEN AND MCCULLOUGH of the House and PADDACK of the Senate.

An Act relating to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training; requiring execution of certain agreement between the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training and peace officers attending the basic law enforcement academy; providing for civil action remedy upon violation of contract; providing for attorney fees and costs; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 3311.11 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:
4 A. Beginning November 1, 2009, any peace officer attending a basic law
5 enforcement academy conducted by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
6 Training (CLEET) shall execute an agreement with CLEET whereby the peace officer
7 promises to remain within the law enforcement profession in the State of Oklahoma in a
8 position approved by rules and regulations of CLEET for four (4) years following
9 graduation from the basic law enforcement academy, subject only to such
10 disqualifications as established by CLEET and included within the agreement between
11 CLEET and the peace officer.

1 B. Violation of the provisions of this section or the terms of any contract or
2 agreement entered into pursuant to this section shall give rise to a civil action which may
3 be commenced by CLEET for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma for restitution of
4 any and all sums paid by CLEET on behalf of the peace officer plus costs and reasonable
5 attorney fees.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
