9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission for
11 Teacher Preparation; making an appropriation; stating
12 purpose; providing for budgeting of funds in certain
13 categories and amounts; requiring performance
14 measures for budget categories; providing for duties
15 and compensation of employees; limiting the maximum
16 salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary
17 limitations; requiring budgeting of certain funds in
18 certain years; requiring certain budget procedures;
19 prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing
20 lapse dates; providing an effective date; and
21 declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
24 Commission for Teacher Preparation from any monies not otherwise
appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars
(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
imposed upon the Commission for Teacher Preparation by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation shall budget all funds
3 in the following categories and amounts:

7 The Commission shall develop outcome-based performance measures
8 for each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation by law shall be
12 set by the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher
13 Preparation. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed
14 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
15 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Commission
16 for Teacher Preparation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
17 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
18 time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to
19 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

22 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
23 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
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1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
3 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
4 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
5 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
8 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
15 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
16 approved by the Office of State Finance.

17 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

18 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
