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9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma House of
11 Representatives; making an appropriation; stating
12 purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; requiring
certain approval for claims and payrolls; providing
an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House
17 of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
18 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2010, the following amount, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary to pay monthly salaries, per diem, and expenses of
21 the members of the House of Representatives and the salaries of its
22 employees, and such contingent expenses as may be ordered paid
23 therefrom, including the preparation and printing of the journals
24 and calendars of the House of Representatives, and including the

1 preparation and printing of the permanent journals thereof, in
2 accordance with the following amount herein set forth:

3 For expenses of personal services (including
4 retirement and insurance costs), including those
5 of members, and employees of the House of
6 Representatives, and expenses of maintenance and
7 operation, including travel expenses, supplies,
8 materials, printing, equipment, and printing of
9 permanent journals, session laws, and
10 supplements; and for the renovation and
11 modification of the House of Representatives
12 area; and other necessary expenses \$_____00

13 Claims and payrolls filed against the appropriation made to the
14 House of Representatives for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
15 shall be approved by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

16 SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
17 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
18 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
19 months from the date this act is approved.

20 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

21 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
