8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Senate; making
10 an appropriation; stating purpose; making
11 appropriation nonfiscal; providing an effective date;
and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
16 Senate from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
17 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
18 30, 2010, the following amount, or so much thereof as may be
19 necessary to pay monthly salaries, per diem, and expenses of the
20 members of the Senate and the salaries of its employees, and such
21 contingent expenses as may be ordered paid therefrom, including the
22 preparation and printing of the journals and calendars of the
23 Senate, and including the preparation and printing of the permanent

1 journals thereof, in accordance with the following amount herein set
2 forth:

3 For expenses of personal services
4 (including retirement and insurance
5 costs), including those of members, and
6 employees of the Senate, and expenses
7 of maintenance and operation, including
8 travel expenses, supplies, materials,
9 printing, equipment, and printing of
10 permanent journals and for the
11 renovation and modification of the
12 Senate area \$0.00

13 SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
14 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
15 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
16 months from the date this act is approved.

17 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

18 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
