8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Space Industry
11 Development Authority; making an appropriation;
12 directing transfer; stating purpose; budgeting funds
13 in certain categories and amounts; providing for the
14 duties and compensation of employees; limiting the
15 salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary
16 limitations; providing exceptions to the budgetary
17 limitations; providing lapse dates; providing an
18 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Space
22 Industry Development Authority from any monies not otherwise
23 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars
(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
imposed upon the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority by
law. The monies appropriated in this section shall be transferred
to the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority Revolving Fund

1 created pursuant to Section 5208.1 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
4 Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority shall budget all funds
5 in the following categories and amounts:

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority by law shall
11 be set by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive
12 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable
13 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma
14 Space Industry Development Authority for the fiscal year ending June
15 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
16 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding
17 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
18 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
19 the Oklahoma Statutes:

23 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
3 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
4 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
5 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
8 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
15 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
16 approved by the Office of State Finance.

17 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

18 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
