8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Workers' Compensation Court;  
10 making appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
11 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
12 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
13 providing budgetary limitations; providing lapse  
14 dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget  
15 procedures; providing an effective date; and  
16 declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Workers'  
19 Compensation Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
20 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
21 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
22 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
23 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law.

24 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
Workers' Compensation Court shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
7 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law shall be set by the  
8 Administrator of the Workers' Compensation Court. The Workers'  
9 Compensation Court for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall  
10 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
11 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
12 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
13 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
14 Statutes:

18 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
19 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
20 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be  
21 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).  
22 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
23 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds  
24 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall

1 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
2 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June  
3 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse  
4 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
5 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
6 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay  
7 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after  
8 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
9 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
10 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been  
11 approved by the Office of State Finance.

12 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

13 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
