House Bill No. 1411

HOUSE BILL NO. 1411 - By: NELSON of the House and LAMB of the Senate.

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.5, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter 3, O.S.L. 2008 (21 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 1290.5), which relates to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; clarifying time limitations for concealed handgun licenses and renewals; updating language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.5, as last amended by
2 Section 16, Chapter 3, O.S.L. 2008 (21 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 1290.5), is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 Section 1290.5

5 TERM OF LICENSE AND RENEWAL

6 A. A concealed handgun license when issued shall authorize the person to whom
7 the license is issued to carry a loaded or unloaded concealed handgun as authorized by
8 the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, and any future modifications thereto.
9 The license shall be valid in this state for a period of five (5) or ten (10) years, unless
10 subsequently surrendered, suspended or revoked as provided by law. The person shall
11 have no authority to continue to carry a concealed handgun in this state pursuant to the

1 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act when a license is expired or when a license has been
2 voluntarily surrendered or suspended or revoked for any reason.

3 B. A license may be renewed any time within ninety (90) days prior to the
4 expiration date as provided in this subsection. The Bureau shall send a renewal
5 application to each eligible licensee with a return address requested. There shall be a
6 thirty-day grace period on license renewals beginning on the date of expiration,
7 thereafter the license is considered expired. However, any applicant shall have three (3)
8 years from the expiration of the license to comply with the renewal requirements of this
9 section.

10 1. To renew a handgun license, the licensee must first obtain a renewal form from
11 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

12 2. The applicant must complete the renewal form, attach two current passport size
13 photographs of the applicant, and submit a renewal fee in the amount of Eighty-five
14 Dollars (\$85.00) to the Bureau. The renewal fee may be paid with a nationally
15 recognized credit card as provided in subparagraph b of paragraph 4 of subsection A of
16 Section 1290.12 of this title, or by a cashier's check or money order made payable to the
17 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

18 3. Upon receipt of the renewal application, photographs and fee, the Bureau will
19 conduct a criminal history records name search, an investigation of medical records or
20 other records or information deemed by the Bureau to be relevant to the renewal
21 application. If the applicant appears not to have any prohibition to renewing the

1 handgun license, the Bureau shall issue the renewed license for a period of five (5) or ten
2 (10) years.

3 C. ~~Upon the effective date of this act~~ Beginning November 1, 2007, any person
4 making application for a concealed handgun license or any licensee seeking to renew a
5 concealed handgun license shall have the option to request that said license be valid for a
6 period of ten (10) years. The fee for any concealed handgun license issued for a period of
7 ten (10) years shall be double the amount of the fee provided for in paragraph 4 of
8 subsection A of Section 1290.12 of this title. The renewal fee for a concealed handgun
9 license issued for a period of ten (10) years shall be double the amount of the fee provided
10 for in paragraph 2 of subsection B of this section.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
