House Bill No. 1419

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1419 - By: CANNADAY of the House.

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1740.1 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:

4 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter upon any premises with intent to
5 steal or remove without the consent of the owner, or with intent to aid or assist in
6 stealing or removing any dimensional stone product. Any person violating the provisions
7 of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in
8 the custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than one (1) year nor more than
9 five (5) years, or by a fine of not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more
10 than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

11 B. As used in this section, "dimensional stone product" means any natural rock
12 material quarried for the purpose of obtaining blocks or slabs that meet specifications as

1 to size and shape. Varieties of dimensional stone shall include, but not be limited to,
2 granite, limestone, marble, sandstone or slate.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
