House Bill No. 1769

HOUSE BILL NO. 1769 - By: ROAN of the House and CRUTCHFIELD of the Senate.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the State Representative Terry Hyman Memorial Highway; designating the Carsyn Kay Hackler Memorial Highway; designating the M/SGT Ura M. Horton Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1698.43 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 That portion of State Highway 32 from Interstate 35 west to the Jefferson County
5 Line shall be designated as “State Representative Terry Hyman Memorial Highway”.
6 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
7 on the highway bearing that name.

8 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
9 Statutes as Section 1698.44 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
10 numbering, reads as follows:

11 That portion of State Highway 63 from Kiowa extending east approximately three
12 (3) miles to Pittsburg shall be designated as “Carsyn Kay Hackler Memorial Highway”.

1 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
2 on the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
4 Statutes as Section 1698.45 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
5 numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge on State Highway 48 approximately five (5) miles south of Allen in
7 Pontotoc County shall be designated the "M/SGT Ura M. Horton Memorial Bridge". The
8 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on
9 the bridge bearing that name.

10 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
12 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
