House Bill No. 1928

HOUSE BILL NO. 1928 - By: SMITHSON of the House and CORN of the Senate.

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.26, as amended by Section 9, Chapter 465, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 1290.26), which relates to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; modifying scope of reciprocal agreement authority; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.26, as amended by
2 Section 9, Chapter 465, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 1290.26), is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 Section 1290.26

5 RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT AUTHORITY

6 The State of Oklahoma hereby recognizes any valid concealed carry weapons permit
7 or license issued by another state.

8 Any person entering this state in possession of a firearm authorized for concealed
9 carry upon the authority and license of another state is authorized to continue to carry a
10 concealed firearm and license in this state; provided the license from the other state
11 remains valid. The firearm must be carried fully concealed from detection and view, and
12 upon coming in contact with any peace officer of this state, the person must disclose the
13 fact that ~~he or she~~ the person is in possession of a concealed firearm pursuant to a valid

1 concealed carry weapons permit or license issued in another state. Any person who is
2 twenty-one (21) years of age or older having a valid firearm license from another state
3 ~~may~~ shall apply for a concealed handgun license in this state ~~immediately~~ within one (1)
4 year upon establishing a residence in this state. The firearm license issued from another
5 state shall cease to be valid in Oklahoma once the person has established residency in
6 this state and has been issued a concealed handgun license pursuant to the provisions of
7 the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
