House Bill No. 1934

HOUSE BILL NO. 1934 - By: JACKSON of the House.

( labor - Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act - modifying fees - effective  
date -  
emergency )

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 141.16, as last amended by  
2 Section 1, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2008 (40 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 141.16), is amended to  
3 read as follows:

4 Section 141.16

5 A. 1. a. Annual certificate of operation fee shall be as follows:

- 6 (1) with manway state inspector \$75.00
- 7 (2) without manway state inspector \$50.00
- 8 (3) any size special - or owner/user inspector \$50.00
- 9 (4) each public hot water supply heater
- 10 (biennially) \$5.00
- 11 (5) each public boiler inspection/certification \$25.00

12 b. Only one certificate of operation fee per year may be charged; except  
13 an additional fee equal to the certificate of operation fee may be

1 charged for witnessing a hydrostatic test required after repairs,  
 2 provided a fee equal to the total fees identified in division (1) or (2) of  
 3 subparagraph a of this paragraph, whichever is appropriate, and  
 4 subparagraph f of paragraph 2 of this subsection may be charged when  
 5 the pressure-retaining item is not prepared and ready pursuant to  
 6 rules promulgated by the Commissioner of Labor at the time of the  
 7 inspection.

1           c.       all fees listed in subparagraphs b, g and h of paragraph 2 of subsection  
2                    A of this section.

3           D. All fees shall be paid directly to the Department of Labor.

4           E. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the  
5 Department of Labor to be designated the "Safety Standards Revolving Fund". The fund  
6 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of  
7 monies collected by the Department and specifically designated for deposit pursuant to  
8 the Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act. Expenditures from said fund shall be made  
9 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law  
10 with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

11       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

12       SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
13 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof  
14 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
