House Bill No. 2071

HOUSE BILL NO. 2071 - By: MCNIEL AND MCMULLEN of the House.

An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2001, Section 9-136, which relates to buying livestock prior to consignment; prohibiting certain act; providing punishment; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2001, Section 9-136, is amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 Section 9-136. A. No person shall buy or offer to buy livestock on the premises  
4 owned and used by a person operating a livestock auction market before the livestock has  
5 been regularly consigned for sale.

6 B. No person, with the intent to defraud, shall offer for sale any livestock at a  
7 livestock auction market in any name other than that of the seller. Any person, with the  
8 intent to defraud, who attempts to sell or sells livestock under a false name or a name  
9 other than that of the seller shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
